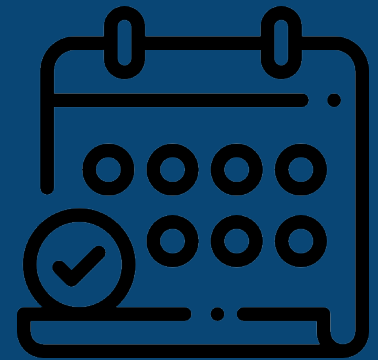
How long you can stay

2 years

Extend your visa

If you want to stay longer, you must re-apply with a new endorsement before your current visa expires.

However you can only stay for a total of 2 years even if you're granted a new visa with a new endorsement.
